



Knights of Columbus Funds - Year End Tax Distributions

The Knights of Columbus Funds declared a capital gain distribution this year for holders of the Knights of Columbus Large Cap Value Fund (KCVIX & KCVSX), Knights of Columbus Small Cap Equity Fund (KCSIX & KCSSX), Knights of Columbus Real Estate Fund (KCRIX), Knights of Columbus Long/Short Equity Fund (KCEIX) and the Knights of Columbus U.S. All Cap Index Fund (KCXIX) (“Funds” or “Fund”).

For holders of the Knights of Columbus Core Bond Fund, Knights of Columbus Limited Duration Fund, Knights of Columbus Large Cap Growth Fund and Knights of Columbus International Equity Fund (“Funds” or “Fund”), no required capital gain distribution is required this year.
